The main gaps are a missing conclusions section, limited discussion of unexpected findings, and poor explanation of sampling. | Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 7The evaluation clearly includes GEEW in the scope of analysis - including a standalone objective and a focus on VAW. The evaluation framework includes a standalone criterion on GE/HR, along with 3 questions; but the evaluation framework does not include any indicators (the results framework of the object does include indicators related to EVAW). The evaluation includes both standalone criteria and questions on GE/HR, along with reference to VAW in some of the other evaluation criteria and questions. The evaluation was limited by very constrained time. Within these constraints the evaluation applied a robust participatory (mostly qualitative) design to ensure the voice of institutional stakeholders was equitably included. Appropriate ethical standards were applied given the subject of the evaluation. Within the constriants of the evidence the evaluation provides a systematic gender analysis and applies a human rights based approach to considering the extent to which the evaluation object addressed the root causes of VAW.
